The chanDam for the song is :

[thana-thanana] [thana-thanana] [thana-thanana] [thana-thanana]  
[thana-thanana] [thana-thanana] [thana-thAnA]

(thana + thanana) = (2 + 3) = 5 mAtrAs

(thana + thAnA) = 2 + 6 = 6 mAtrAs

The first line has 4 units with 5 mAtrAs in each unit. The second line has 2 units with 5 mAtrAs and the 'thongal' having 6 mAtrAs. In many songs Guruji has expanded / elongated the 'thongal' to add to the melody. In this song, he added 4 more mAtrAs to the thongal, thus making the second line also to have 4 units with 5 mAtrAs in each unit.

Guruji has set the thALam for this song as 'khaNda chApu' = thaka-thakita.

Comment:

Following the discussion for the song 'pakkarai-vichithra-maNi', this song could be sung in 'ADi tALa in khaNda nadai' or 'chathusra Ekam in khaNda nadai'. But all these three thALAs have the same rhythmic pattern.
