The chanDam for the song is :

[thanA-thanana] [thAnam] [thanA-thanana] [thAnam]
[thanA-thanana] [thAnam] [thana-thAna]

(thanA-thanana) = 3 + 3 = 6 mA+Aas = thaka - Dhimi - thaka
(thAnam) = 4 mAtrAs = thaka - Dhimi

The 'thongal' has 5 mAtrAs. In many songs Guruji has expanded / elongated the 'thongal' to add to the melody. In this song, he added 5 more mAtrAs, thus making the 'thongtal' to have 10 mAtrAs.

With this, we have the 'thaka - Dhimi - thaka' + 'thaka - Dhimi' = 3 + 2 = thisra rUpakam (vilOma nadai). Thisra rUpakam is 'Drutham + thisra lagu'. In this case, we have 'thisra lagu + Drutham'.
