The chanDam for the song is :

(thanana) = 3 mA+Aas

= thakita

(thAna) = 3 mA+Aas

= thakita

(thA-nana) = 5 mA+As

= thaka - thakita

Total 2 units of 11 mA+As in the first line and one unit of 11 mA+As in the second line, followed by a 'thongal' having 5 mA+As. In this song, Guruji added 6 more mA+As, to make the 'thongal' also to have 11 mA+As.

With this, we have the 4 units of  $5\frac{1}{2}$  aksharam thALam, with the following nadai for each unit: 'thakita -thakita - thaka -thakita'.
