The chanDam for the song is :

[thanattha-tthath-] [thanattha-tthath-] [thanattha-tthath-]  
[thanattha-tthath]

(thanattha-tthath-) = 7 mA+Aas = thakita - thaka - Dhimi  
(thanathAna) = 5 mAtrAs = ?

The 'thongal' has 5 mAtrAs. Guruji added 9 more to the 'thongal', to make it 14 mAtrAs. With this, each line of the song will have 4 units of 7 mAtrAs in each line = 4 times (thakita - thaka - Dhimi) = chathusra Ekam in misra nadai. If you take two lines together, you get chathusra thriputai (ADi) thALam in misra nadai.
