The chanDam for the song is:

The first three lines have

(3 + 5 + 5 + 5) = 18 units = 9 aksharam in maDhyama kAlam followed by 'thongal' with 6 mAtrAs. Guruji added 12 more mAtrAs to make it 18 mAtrAs, equal to the full thALam.

Thus the thALam for the song is (thakita) (thakita - thaka) (thakita - thaka) (thakita - thaka) for the three lines as well as the 'thongal'.
