

Asai-nAlu-chathura

The chanDam for the song is :

[thAna] [thAna-thana] [thattha-thana] [thattha-thana]
[thAna] [thAna-thana] [thattha-thana] [thattha-thana]
[thAna] [thAna-thana] [thattha-thana] [thattha-thana] [thantha-thAna]

(thAna) = 3 mAttrAs = thakita
(thAna-thana) = 3 + 2 = 5 mAttrAs = thakita - thaka
(thattha-thana) = 3 + 2 = 5 mAttrAs = thakita - thaka
(thantha-thAna) = 3 + 3 = 6 mAttrAs = ?

The first three lines have

(3 + 5 + 5 + 5) = 18 units = 9 aksharam in maDhyama kAlam followed by 'thongal' with 6 mAttrAs. Guruji added 12 more mAttrAs to make it 18 mAttrAs, equal to the full thALam.

Thus the thALam for the song is (thakita) (thakita - thaka) (thakita - thaka) (thakita - thaka) for the three lines as well as the 'thongal'.
